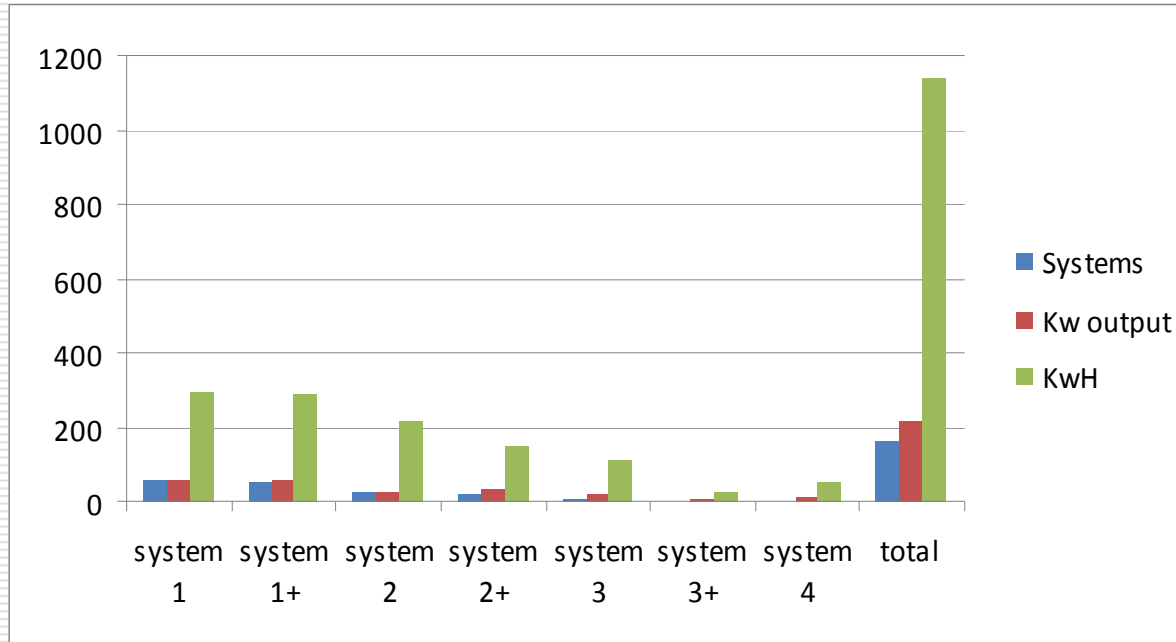
BAROSSA C-PREP PROGRAM

 - 98 ready to go



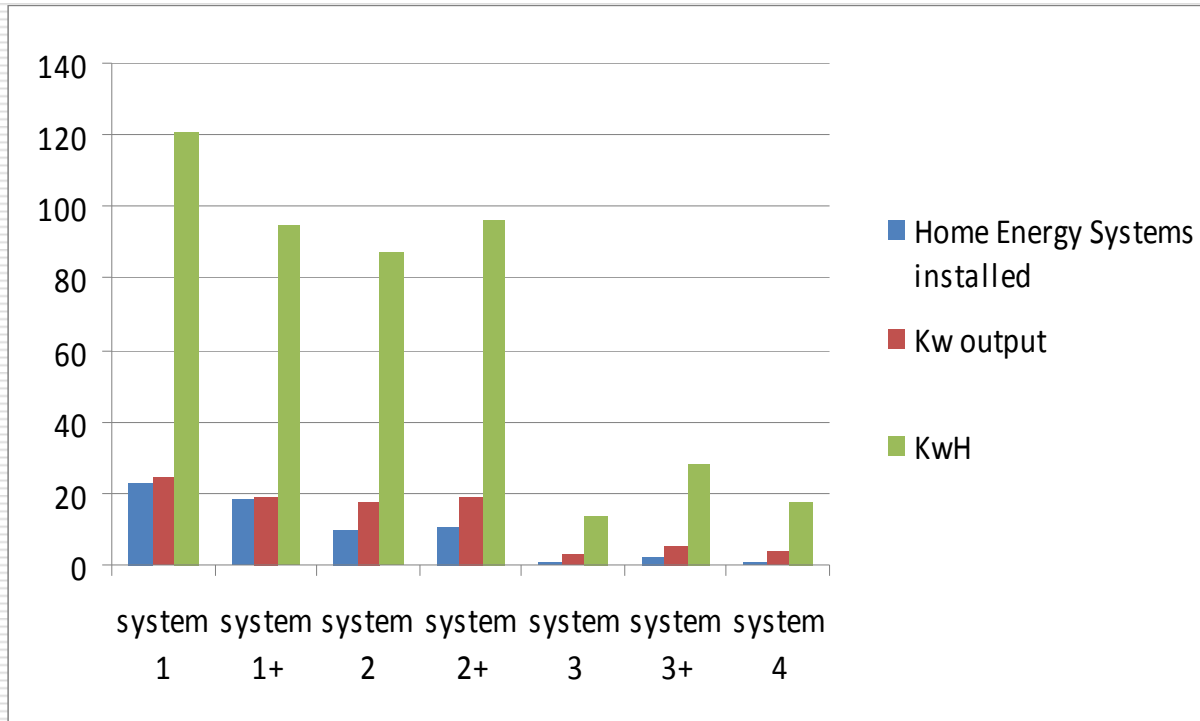
BAROSSA C-PREP PROGRAM
