

## City of Holdfast Bay / KESAB Clean Site Program

Building is one of Australia's major industries. We must be aware of the impact that construction can have on our environment. The Clean Site Program provides ways in which the construction and building industries can minimise that impact.

When working on a building project, site maintenance is important. Soil, litter and waste that runs off building sites enters directly into stormwater drains.

Remember stormwater is not treated and sediments and other pollutants destroy life in our creeks, rivers and beaches. This can mean an end to all the things that you and your family enjoy that need clean, safe water, such as fishing and swimming.

Because the consequences of polluted runoff entering our waterways are so serious, if you are caught polluting by authorities such as local council or the EPA, on-the-spot fines and penalties apply for offenders.

The Clean Site Program demonstrates a number of simple steps you can take to minimise the risk, avoid fines and penalties, and ensure that best environmental practices are implemented.
