

# **Emerging Civic Leaders Program 2021: Overview**

The Emerging Civic Leaders program helps young people understand the principles of values-driven leadership, develop the skills needed to build community and meaningfully participate in our civic system.

This year's program ran for 6 weeks in April and May, with 84 leaders taking part across 7 local teams. During the program, they heard from a range of expert mentors across 5 main topic areas:

During the program, in teams our young leaders had to collaborate to design, test and run an activation to consult large numbers of young people, taking their findings to a local decision maker. Due to COVID restrictions, and geography, activations included online and offline elements, ranging from network-effect pledge chains that harnessed social media, to offline interactions at key locations like markets, festivals and tertiary education campuses. Together, our leaders reached 936 young people in their communities.


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## **National Cohort Evaluation**

The National Cohort of the 2021 Emerging Civic Leaders program was our biggest yet, with **84 leaders** selected from hundreds of applications.

These leaders participated in the **6 week program** in **7 local teams.** Together they consulted **936 young people** in their communities, and took their concerns and ideas to every level of government.

Our consultations told us that the **top five issues for young people** in Australia are:



During consultations, our leaders also spoke with their peers about the importance of our democratic process. Nationally, **one in every five young people** our leaders spoke to updated their voter enrolment or enrolled for the first time as a result of the consultation.

In evaluating the program, our National Cohort told us that as a result of participating in Emerging Civic Leaders 2021:

94% are more likely to engage with their local council.

94% feel more confident articulating themselves and their perspectives.

91% developed skills that they will use in every area of their life (ie. study, work).

91% built a new relationship with someone that they will stay connected with.

Overall, our participants rated the Emerging Civic Leaders program as 4.4 out of 5.
