Special Local Roads Program – governance review

Inception meeting with Hudson Howells to identify LGTAP view of current issues and priorities

Project Description

The LGA has engaged Hudson Howells to prepare a report of research findings and provide recommendations to form updated governance arrangements, policies and processes of the Special Local Road Program.

Objectives

The objectives of the review are to:

- Determine contemporary governance arrangements, policies and processes that support the SLRP.
- Provide reliable insights and assessment from a range of affected stakeholders to ensure the LGA's integrity in administering the SLRP.
- Ensure Commonwealth, State and local government deliver value for money for local communities in the administration of grant funds.
- Ensure that projects supported by the SLRP are built and maintained to the appropriate
 Australian roads design standards and meet the Minister's Statement of Expectations for the
 Roads to Recovery fund.

Current issues and priorities

As outlined in the consultancy brief, it is acknowledged that the current governance arrangements, policies and processes are adequate for the management of the SLRP.

However, there are some current issues and key risks that the LGA is seeking to address.

In advance of the meeting on Friday, 3 July 2020, LGTAP members are asked to review and prioritise the issues listed in Table 1.

Prioritisation is intended to give Hudson Howells a further understanding of the issues prior to discussion with LGTAP and is not a process to rule out any issues that may need to be addressed as the review progresses.

- It was noted that some large projects are seeking funding from other funding sources and we are not being notified of this. The Panel would like to see this become part of the application process i.e. once they have applied for the program, ask if they have applied elsewhere and if they have been successful, before the Panel meets to deliberate.
- Some of the large projects do not appear to be through the approval stage
 yet and there are DA's relying on grant funding to upgrade works to make
 the project work. Projects need to be shovel ready to warrant funding to
 ensure the project goes ahead irrespective of contributions from
 developers. Projects need to be approved, planned and ready.
- It was noted that no applications were received this year for the following continuing projects that were funded in the 2019/20 program:

Stage 1 included stormwater and a bridge widening- this is 100% completed.

Stage 2 included all formation, excavation, pavement construction and sealing. Also included was Guard Railing across the Wedgewood Road Bridge and linemarking. Final sign installation and reconciliation of last invoices/purchase orders will be completed by June 30th.

There were cost extras associated with Stage 2, and these were associated with:

- a) Delays and damaged caused by the KI Bushfires complex of December 2019 to February 2020- reinstatement of survey and other damage and clean up to vegetation along the entire road upgrade alignment
- b) Additional cut/fill volumes required due to compliance requirements with Austroads design guidelines in relation to shoulder widths and batter gradients
- c) Re-establishment costs following the Bushfire event
- d) Increased spray sealing costs associated with CRS Emulsion purchase pricing.

The road proper was opened to traffic fully after sealing operations were completed on 2nd April 2020.

The road geometry and surface treatment has performed very satisfactorily and above expectations. K I Council have fielded a significant number of expressions of thanks for the completion of this part of the entire project- with many residents and users aware of the significant increase in road safety brought about by the project works.

A further benefit in the road safety arena is the completion of the staggered intersection of Wedgewood/Hickmans/East West Hwy intersection- these type of layouts are being installed across KI as Council upgrade road sections.

Kangaroo Island Council, residents and road users thank the LGTAP for the opportunity to upgrade this road which will provide long term Social, Community, Freight and Tourism benefits.

The project mentioned above has now been completed which has improved freight movements for not only the locals that utilise the road but also the freight vehicles travelling to the grain storage area at Viterra Silos, Apamurra during peak farming and agricultural periods.

As suggested the reconstruction and widening of the road surface process has allowed for the desired adequate drainage, which has also improved the road safety during all-weather conditions. Addressing the safety issues raised in the previously mentioned Road Safety Audit. Significant work has put into reconstruction of the pavement to ensure additional drainage on the road which can now handle increased heavy vehicle use safely and with longevity. Although a significant amount of work has been done to improve the pavement of the road, the initial budget and expectation was based on an sub-standard pavement. Results of the laboratory testing on the pavement strength was better than expected, meaning the project is likely to come in under budget.

Naracoorte Lucindale Council is seeking to establish the Old Caves Road as the primary link between Naracoorte township and Naracoorte Caves, South Australia's only World Heritage Site and a major regional visitor attraction. This link will be complemented with walking and bike trails, as well as an interpretative trail. The need for this was identified by Council and the community and supported through a project called "Caves Connections", coordinated by Council consisting of community and business members.

Works will involve the reconstruction of Old Caves Road to a suitable standard for tourism traffic.

This includes the re-construction of 5km of road extending north from the Caves Road. The balance of the road is fit for purpose.

Stage 1

Stage 1 works completed in 2018/19 - 3.7 km of road from Caves road to 3.7km north. Works included both vertical and horizontal realignment to meet Australian Standards for a 100km/h road.

The road pavement was constructed to a width of 9.2m and a depth of 300mm. It comprises

2 x 3.1m lanes with a 0.5m sealed shoulder and 1.0m unsealed shoulder.

Stage 2 Urban – current project

Stage 2 works in 2019/20 will involve a complete re-construction of a 1km section of Old Caves Road from the Arthur Street intersection to a point 1 km south of this intersection. The pavement will be constructed from 300mm of 20mm minus crushed rubble and include the replacement of the stormwater drainage infrastructure. There will be significant drainage works required for the construction of the section of road to enclose an open drain. This will eliminate significant local flooding issues associated with the current road geometry. There is provision for a shared path to be included in the construction from Arthur Street to The Sunrise Christian School that will link the school to the CBD footpath Network.

The roadworks are complete, with a small section of stormwater pipe is to be installed following significant delays with Telstra and nbn relocations. The shared path is approximately 50% complete.

Stage 3 Rural

Stage 3 will commence 300m south of Pistol Club Road and finish 1.6km south of Pistol Club Road adjoining the northern end of the 2018-19 Stage 1 construction works. Stage 3 will be constructed to the same design as Stage 1.

The road pavement is in good condition but is narrow, and requires widening to meet the standard of Stage 1. It will be widened each side by 2m with a 1m seal to achieve 2 x 3.1m lanes with a 0.5m sealed shoulder and 1.0m unsealed shoulder.

The intersection with Pinkerton Road will be realigned to bring Pinkerton Road to Old Caves Road at 90 degrees. This will include replacement of culverts and 50m of road construction and sealing works.
