



LOCAL GOVERNMENT TRANSPORT ADVISORY PANEL

MINUTES

Meeting held on Friday, 3 June 2016 from 10am to 12:30pm
in the Civic Centre at City of Port Adelaide Enfield

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The purpose of the meeting is to undertake consideration of the 2016/17 regional and metropolitan Special Local Roads Program funding submissions.

1. Welcome

2. Apologies

3. Review minutes from previous meetings
 - The panel confirmed the minutes of 3 July 2015 and 20 August 2015 to be a true and correct record of those meetings.
4. Recap of the 2015/16 LGTAP allocations to refresh history/understanding of continuing and new projects
 - The panel discussed the funding allocations made the previous financial year and what impacts they may have on funding for 2016/2017, in particular projects that are continuing.

5. Project Reports for 2015/16 SLRP funded projects
 - Project reports for previously funded projects particularly funded in 2015/2016 were discussed. Some reports are yet to be received. Patricia to follow up outstanding reports and provide a subsequent summary to the Panel.
6. Other business
 - Ryan Road – City of Onkaparinga – commentary from the City of Onkaparinga about Ryan Road was noted
 - Murray Street project – Town of Gawler – the Panel approved the use of the funding as suggested by the Town of Gawler
 - Samuel/Seppeltsfield/Stelzer Roads Intersection – Light Regional Council – the Panel agreed that the amount of unspent funds of \$199,667 will be allocated to the 2016/2017 funding year
 - Kyancutta/Mt Wedge – Elliston Stock route – DC of Ceduna – David Hitchcock provided further information in relation to the status of this project
 - Greenwith Road – City of Tea Tree Gully – the Panel agreed that the City of Tea Tree Gully can retain the underspent funds from this project for use on other community road priorities
 - Metropolitan Hierarchy Maps refresh – the Panel noted that the Metropolitan Hierarchy Maps are outdated and recommends that the Metropolitan Local Government Group undertakes actions to develop a suitable metropolitan roads strategy similar to that of the 5 Regional LGAs.
7. Consideration of 2016/17 SLRP applications
 - Twenty-eight (28) projects with a total of \$15.841 million for 2016/2017 are recommended by the Panel for funding with the following noted for specific projects:
 - Southern Mallee (Geranium South Road) is a continuing project that is already funded at 1.9m if 2016/2017 funding is approved – what is the 3rd year figure? The total funding figure for the three years in the original application was only 1.9m.
 - Mount Barker (Springs Road) Application needs to be revisited – the application when processed through the Roads Prioritisation Database was deemed as a very low priority based on the information currently provided in the application. The Panel feels the application isn't a true reflection of the works that needs to be undertaken.
 - Playford (Peachey Road) and West Torrens (West Thebarton Road) – the Panel would like to see a breakdown of costings. What is the scope of the works to be completed.
 - The Panel would like all applicants to be emailed regarding recommendations of the Panel noting that the final funding allocations and announcements will be made by the respective State and Federal Ministers.
 - The Panel would like a report on historical projects, why project are typically not completed in time, how far off the end of the financial year are they completed and are there any patterns.
