**King Street Bridge – SLRP Funding**

Thank you for your letter of 16 May concerning the above funding application, and advising of your Council's positive response to the potential for funds to be allocated for replacement of the King Street Bridge over a two or three year period. I have informed the Metropolitan Strategic Roads Committee of the views expressed in your letter.

I am pleased to advise that the Committee has unanimously resolved to recommend to the Local Government Transport Advisory Panel (LGTAP) that the City of Holdfast Bay should be invited to resubmit its application next year, on the basis of 50/50 Council and SLRP funding over a two year period. I have communicated this recommendation to LGTAP's Executive Officer, Mr David Hitchcock.

Please note that this decision does not imply the automatic support of the Committee next year, since the new funding application will need to be assessed against others received at the same time. However, it does suggest a way forward.

I understand that LGTAP will meet again on 3 June to consider its final recommendations. I expect that Mr Hitchcock will provide details of the Panel's decision to your Council following that meeting.
